Vocabulary

Music genres, sport, transport, jobs, shops, nature and climate change, technology, our origins, phrasal verbs, forming adjectives and adverbs with suffixes; linkers: addition, time, example, time; strategy: using fillers while thinking, giving examples to clarify ideas, turn taking, fitness and health, relationships.

Grammar

Present simple and adverbs of frequency; present continuous (for actions happening at the time of speaking and with *always* for frequent actions that are annoying); stative verbs; past continuous; past participle and present perfect; first conditional; subject and object questions; direct and indirect questions; past simple vs present perfect; present perfect continuous and duration form; *for* and *since*; question tags; articles, adjectives, adverbs and modifiers; comparatives and superlatives; narrative tenses and past routines: *used to* and *would* + bare infinitive, past simple, past perfect simple and past perfect continuous; plans and arrangements, schedules, predictions, future continuous and future perfect. Linkers: addition, example, time and comparisons.
